- ☐ Gather your financial and tax information so you can easily fill out the FAFSA® (Free Application for Federal Student Aid).

November

December

- ☐ Fill out the FAFSA as soon as it becomes available this month.

- Complete the FAFSA as soon as possible if you haven't already.
- Review your FAFSA Submission Summary and correct any errors.

February

March

- ☐ Head to CollegeCovered.com/Award-Letter-Tool to compare award letter offers.
- ☐ If your financial circumstances have changed, you can appeal your package with your financial aid office.

May 1

It's National Decision Day! Notify the school you plan to attend and deposit no later than today.

June 30

 Last day to apply for the FAFSA for those already in college and seeking financial aid for the year you've just completed.
